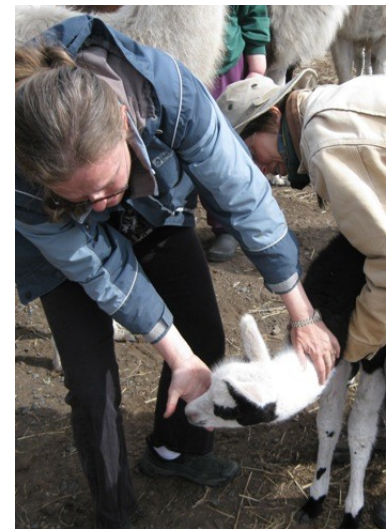
### *PLTA Mentors are a Phone Call Away*
