

Pack Llama Trail Association Web Site Security Policy

Display of Member's Contact Information

I. Definitions.

1. **Minors.** Minors are children under the age of eighteen years.
2. **Associate.** A person, who for the purposes of insurance coverage, has paid fees required by the association in order to participate in PLTA sanctioned events while being covered by the association's insurance policy.
3. **Member.** Members of the Pack Llama Trail Association (PLTA) are individuals, families, or businesses who have paid their membership dues and are otherwise in good standing with the association, and as such, have been awarded full rights and responsibilities as defined in the association's bylaws.

II. Display of Information

1. **Minors.** Names and contact information for minors will not be published on the web site.
2. **Associate.** Contact information for Associates will not be published on the web site
3. **Member.** Contact information for all adult members including name, farm/ranch name (if applicable), state and country of their location, email address and phone number will be available in the private (member's) section of the web site. At a member's request, contact information of their choosing, as well as a brief comment, also of their choosing, will be displayed in the public section of the web site. Members shall be queried on the PLTA Membership application form as to their preferences for the web site display of their contact information.
4. **PLTA Personnel.** Contact information for persons acting on behalf of the PLTA, including members of the Board of Directors, Program Coordinators, committee chairs and team or task force members, shall be displayed in the public section of the web site in the form of name, email address, and phone number, as required by the tasks such individuals are required to perform and the need of the public to contact them.

For the benefit of the members of the association, all of this information will be made available in the private section of the web site.

III. Rationale

1. Minors. This policy is designed to protect minors and their families from predators.
2. Associates. Since the purpose of becoming a PLTA Associate is to acquire insurance coverage in order to participate in PLTA sanctioned events and limited to that privilege, an associate's access to the PLTA web site is limited to the public section. They are not granted the benefit of having their information displayed there or in the private (member's) section of the site.
3. Members. Members of the association need to be able to know who their fellow members are and contact one another, therefore, contact information must be made available. The web site is the most efficient format the Association has for providing this service, therefore, contact information will be provided, but retained behind the security of the area accessed only by members, unless a member specifically requests otherwise.
